

**NOMINATING FORM FOR INVESTIGATOR

This individual must have shown outstanding accomplishments in the previous year in the area of arson investigation, in either the criminal or civil disciplines. They must have investigated or assisted in investigating a significant fire or fires with in the previous year. They must have demonstrated knowledge of the scientific method in solving the fire(s), through the use and testing of hypotheses in the course of the investigation. This may be evidenced by the descriptive details of the fire(s) being submitted for review. If the individual assisted in the fires, then such assistance provided by the individual should be described in detail. The recipient shall be a current member of the Chapter and International, as verified by the Membership Chair. The recipient shall not be a member of the Awards Committee and shall not have received this award in the past 10 years. There shall be only one Investigator of the Year award. If no one meets the qualifications for that year then the award will not be given.
